

Terms and service agreement

Hours of operation are by appointment only; there is no storefront where customers can stop in and "browse." Turnaround time is usually between 24 and 48 hours and may even be the same day in some cases. As this is a part-time vocation and is not my primary occupation, my schedule can be erratic. I will always try and work with you to get the work done as soon as possible.

Firearm Transfers:

As this is a part time occupation, most transfers are done on Friday, Saturday or Sundays UNLESS prior arrangements are made. **I will contact you when the firearm is ready to transfer. This is not when it shows delivered by the shipping company.**

Title I transfers (regular firearms): \$20.00 for Texas CHL Holders (per firearm). A multiple handgun transfer form will be sent in accordance with fed law if 2 or more handguns are purchased within a 5 Business day period.

Title I transfers (regular firearms): \$25.00 for Texas Non-CHL Holders (per firearm). A NICS background check will be performed as required by law. FFL copies will be sent by Email to your dealer at no charge. ABSOLUTELY NO FFL COPIES WILL BE PROVIDED TO ANY UNLICENSED INDIVIDUALS - INDIVIDUALS WITHOUT AN FFL. PER ATF, FFL COPIES ARE TO BE RESERVED FOR LICENSEE TO LICENSEE TRANSFERS ONLY. I WILL FURNISH FFL INFORMATION WHEREBY AN UNLICENSED INDIVIDUAL CAN VERIFY MY FFL AT THE ATF'S FFL E-Z CHECK WEBSITE. Individuals sending firearms for transfer MUST include a copy of their driver's license or state CHL with the package or the firearm WILL NOT be transferred.

Title II Transfers (NFA, "Class 3" weapons): Short barreled rifles and shotguns, silencers, and AOW's are \$50.00 per weapon*; machinegun transfers are \$100.00 per firearm. Fees are based on the customer picking up the paperwork in person; there is an additional \$5.00 fee if transfer paperwork is to be mailed to the customer prior to being processed. There is no additional paperwork "fee" as some other dealers charge.

Transfer fees are due at time of transfer, regardless of NICS outcome (proceed, delay, deny). If denied per NICS check, the firearm MUST be transferred out to another dealer immediately. NO exceptions.

Gunsmith service fees:

Generally, gunsmith services are billed at a rate of **\$75.00** per hour, with a one hour minimum. This includes engraving and repairs / customizing. Shop supplies, such as ammunition for testing and evaluating weapons, will be charged IN ADDITION to the hourly rates. **NO REFINISHING WORK IS DONE AT ALL. MACHINED SURFACES WILL BE BARE OR COATED WITH A THIN LAYER OF RUST PREVENTATIVE. IT IS THE CUSTOMERS RESPONSIBILITY TO HAVE REFINISH WORK DONE AFTER MACHINING. NO WARRENTTEE IS GIVEN ON CUSTOM FINISHES THAT ARE BROUGHT IN FOR MACHINE WORK.**

Most services will require your firearm to be left as our policy is **not** work on customers' firearms while they wait unless there are extenuating circumstances such as duty weapons in the case of law enforcement officers. The exception to this is standard firearm engraving on stripped AR15 type receivers that can normally be done "while you wait."

Barrel threading: For firearms such as the AR15 or 10/22, dismounted (stripped) barrels are generally threaded in industry Standard English threads from \$75.00 for straight, "bull" barrels for suppressor use. Not ALL barrels can be threaded. Exotic rail systems need to have been removed prior to sending the firearm for work. For hard to remove barrels, such as those installed with chemical locking compounds, hourly shop rates may apply. No Noveske and KAC factory installed barrels will be accepted for this work.

Engraving services: Standard engraving, such required information from Form 1 applications (Maker's name, city, and state), are generally engraved from \$50.00 (ALUMINUM receivers only). Carbon steel and Stainless steel receiver engraving starts at \$65.00; the increased cost is due to both the longer time it takes to engrave these hard surfaces as well as the faster wear to the engraving bits. Price is based on a standard of two lines of text; there is an additional \$10.00 fee for adding a third line. All engraving is deep cut on a manual rotary (or diamond scratch point) engraving pantograph machine up to a depth of .015. ATF only requires .003" deep, about the same as a sheet of notebook paper. Lettering is normally blackened at no charge upon customer request.

Minimum shop fee is \$50.00

Customers should be aware that is a part-time business operated outside of normal business hours. Phone calls and emails are normally returned after normal business hours.

Brokering:

Brokering fees are 10% of the sale price of the item or items being sold. This includes all Title I weapons as well as Title II weapons.

Assistance with paperwork: Transfers

There is no fee to assist customers with completing / processing Title II paperwork. For non-customers, that do **not** purchase the item from us, we will assist with ATF paperwork for \$50.00 per weapon.

Cancellations / refunds

Payment is due up-front for all work. Once a firearm has been left at / shipped to RPARMS for service, transfer, or for purchase, there will be a **non-refundable \$25.00** fee for any services cancelled prior to the work being completed; if the weapons involved are NFA weapons, the non-refundable fee will increase to **\$65.00**. These fees are necessary as it takes time to enter firearms in and out of logbooks per ATFE requirements. There is a \$100.00 fee if the transfer of a NFA item is cancelled before approval from the ATF.

Item storage: Upon notification that item is ready to transfer, you will have 10 days to pickup item, unless other arrangements are made PRIOR to accepting the transfer. You have 10 days to send to send in NFA paperwork from time of receiving the NFA packet. I will contact the NFA branch 60 days after I have signed and mailed the proper forms. IF THEY DO NOT HAVE RECORD OF THE TRANSFER and YOU cannot provide proof, (tracking number or cancelled check) proving otherwise within **90 days**, you will be notified by phone or email that an additional fee of \$100 per month will be added until the DEALER cost of the item is reached. At that time the item will be resold to recover fees incurred.
